The Green Industries Best Management Practices (BMPs) are designed to preserve and protect Florida's water resources from non-point-source pollution. The BMPs cover proper fertilization, pest control, irrigation, and cultural practices for landscape and pest control professionals. Knowledge of appropriate fertilizer rates, sources, and application methods can greatly reduce any potential non-point source pollution of Florida's ground and surface waters. Although adoption of the BMPs is voluntary at this time, legislation passed in July 2009 will require anyone who applies fertilizer to obtain an applicator's license called the Limited Certification for Urban Landscape Commercial Fertilizer Application by January 2014. BMP certification (taking the GIBMP course and passing the exam with a 75% or higher) will be the pre-requisite to obtain the license. Other local ordinances may require it as well.
